



Lorain County clinches winning road trip, sweeps 2-game series

Pitchers had a tough day during the game between the Lorain County Ironmen (6-6) and the Springfield Sliders (1-9), as the two teams put up 19 runs combined in an 11-8 the Lorain County Ironmen win.

The teams totaled 21 hits in the game.

Lucas Raley racked up three RBIs on three hits for the Lorain County Ironmen. He doubled in the fourth innings and singled in the fifth and sixth innings.

He was on base following five of his six at bats.

Andrew Gronski also had a notable day, going 2-5 with a homerun (his first) and two RBIs.

The Ironemen hitting is starting to come together. After falling to last place in batting average a week ago, the bats have come alive of late. The team average is now .223, up almost 40 points.

Nick Riotto led the Springfield Sliders' offensive threat, as he got on base four times in the game. He scored two runs and had one RBI. He doubled in the sixth inning and singled in the second and ninth innings.

Sam Clarke recorded his first win of the year for the Lorain County Ironmen. He allowed three runs over six innings. He struck out one, walked three and surrendered seven hits.

JC DeMuri (0-1) was the game's losing pitcher. He lasted two innings in relief, walked one, struck out none, and allowed two runs.
